#### UPDATED WATER CONSERVATION RULES FOR BOERNE UTILITY CUSTOMERS

##### Stage 1 Restrictions

- ⇒ Landscape watering with sprinklers is ONLY allowed between 7pm & 11am and ONLY on designated days according to street address
- ⇒ Hand watering, with hose or bucket, or with soaker hose is allowed any day, any time, but not recommended between 11am and 7pm to avoid evaporation loss
- ⇒ Vehicle washing at home is permitted with pail or bucket & with positive shut-off nozzles only
- ⇒ Properly functioning drip irrigation allowed
- ⇒ Identify and eliminate defective plumbing
- ⇒ No wasting of water

##### Conservation Tips

- ⇒ Use mulch in your landscape beds to avoid moisture loss
- ⇒ Use soaker hoses in landscape beds
- ⇒ For best effectiveness, lawns need no more than 1" of water per week
- ⇒ Create watering zones in your yard & only water those areas near house foundation
- ⇒ If using a sprinkler system (2x / week only), be sure that sprinkler heads are watering yard and garden areas, not pavement
- ⇒ Use a broom instead of water to clean sidewalks, patios and driveways
- ⇒ Take short showers rather than baths
- ⇒ Only run washing machines and dish washers with full loads

Your sewer calculation can be effected by watering landscaping and new sod. Water usage during the winter months, December through March, directly effects your sewer rate calculation for the entire year. Therefore, you should understand that an increase in water usage December—March, indoors or outdoors, will cause an increase in your sewer rate beginning April 1 of each year.

**Outdoor watering with sprinklers allowed only on designated days as determined by the last number of home or business address.**
