Antonio's entry was drawn from the pool of correct entries submitted. A resident of Boerne, Martinez enjoyed participating in this year's contest.

"We walk down Main Street each Sunday after church and we've been amazed to find things that we walk by every day and just don't see," Martinez said. "We've been participating in the contest about four years now and really enjoy it. It's fun, educational and a great way to learn more about our community—in fact, each year we keep an extra copy of the poster and use it to show out-of-town guests around when they visit!"

Each year during May's National Preservation Month, a poster featuring 30 photos of historically significant icons, architecture and landmarks along and around Boerne's historic downtown area, known as the Hill Country Mile, is distributed and scavenger hunters must find and correctly identify the photos. A drawing is held from all correct entries, and the winner is given a prize package provided from retailers and restaurants along the Hill Country Mile.

This year Martinez will receive "A Taste of Boerne" package for two consisting of gift certificates for breakfast at Bear Moon Bakery & Cafe, lunch at Boerne Epicure Gourmet Market, dinner at The Creek Restaurant, fine wine at the Boerne Wine Company, refreshing Kelani Yogurt and shopping gift certificates to The Victorian Rose and Dienger Trading Company in historic Downtown Boerne.
