**Must be on the list - call before May 13; then set your junk out by May 15**

**ATTENTION BOERNE UTILITY CUSTOMERS:**  
To have your items picked up, you must register with the Utility Customer Service Office by calling 249-9511 between the hours of 8am and 5pm Monday through Friday.

Friday, May 13, is the deadline to call and get your address on the list! Customers must remove any items that have been placed at the curb if they did not request the pick up by the deadline.

You can also request this service from the city's website or from the City of Boerne mobile app (free in the App Store).
