Don't mow those wildflowers yet!

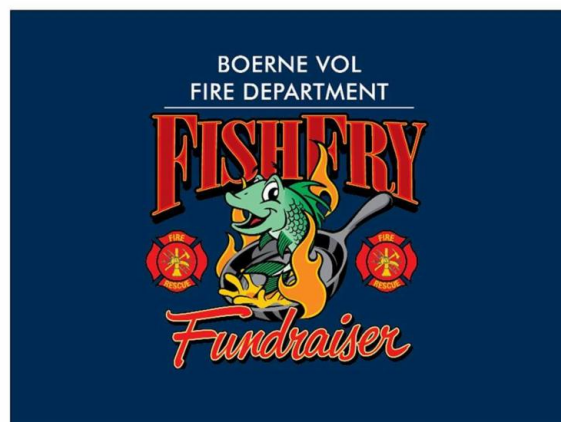
Thanks to the spring rains we are enjoying public landscapes painted with the pinks, yellows, blues, and purples of Texas. Those images will soon give way to the oranges, yellows and browns of a south Texas summer.

The standard practice is to halt mowing of designated wildflower areas from January until mid-June so the flowers have time to disperse their seeds insuring another beautiful hill country spring.

According to the Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center it takes 8-10 weeks after the bloom before the flowers have the opportunity to seed out and lay their foundation for next spring.

ATTENTION BOERNE UTILITY CUSTOMERS: To have your items picked up, you must register with the Utility Customer Service Office by calling 249-9511 between the hours of 8am and 5pm Monday through Friday.

Friday, May 12, is the deadline to call and get your address on the list! Customers must remove any items that have been placed at the curb if they did not request the pickup by the deadline.

These can include vases, pet water bowls, flowerpot saucers, discarded tires, buckets, pool covers, birdbaths, trash cans, and rain barrels.
