### Sewer Smoke Testing continues in Boerne

Weather permitting, BoerneUtilities work crews will be conducting smoke test surveys throughout Boerne over the next several months. This testing is a very effective way for crews to locate leaks, breaks and defects in the city's sewer system. Residents may see harmless smoke coming from the vent stacks on houses or holes in the ground. The smoke is non-toxic and non-staining, has no odor, is white to gray in color, and does not create a fire hazard.
